### **Old Business**

### **New Business**

Update on Reading Support-Michelle Stratton

- Michelle explained the program she uses for students
- Works with students who struggle with reading and content comprehension
- These students are years behind grade level reading
- Works in small groups, 1 on 1
- She takes reading data from EHMS, reassess them for proper placement
- Members viewed a graph of the data showing student improvement in reading
- Program teaches students to go back to basic reading-using phonetics
- Wilson Reading program is a good for students because it improves their reading ability and students see the results
- There is a correlation between reading and doing well in school-comprehension, grades, attendance
- If intervention occurs in the younger grades, students will have a better success rate as they get older

Budget Update

- Will have a carryover due to the Behavioral Support Staff that hasn't been filled
- If no hire happens by next meeting, we will need to shift money for other school needs to prevent a carryover above 10%
- Will have a budget update at next meeting

- To count days, Day 0 is the day of testing positive, then Day 1 is the day after, Day 2, Day 3 and so forth
