New Business SIP

- Goal 1
 - Our proficiency scores have improved per the results of RISE and ASPIRE tests
 - > TMJH is now a "A" school compared to 6 years ago
 - Our proficiency scores have improved through all areas-Read, Write, Math, Science
- Action A
 - Funding a Reading Bridge class 34%

- Action B
 - Branching Minds Tier1-all classes are using this level; Tier 2,3-gives more info on how to service students
 - Currently TMJH SIP is paying (\$6,400) for this program, but would like the DO to take over as the District is paying for other schools
- Action C
 - Some CORE teachers are part of the ELL Cohort which is funded by SIP
 - > These teachers work one on one with students to help them comprehend the material
- Goal 2
 - ➤ This focuses on increasing the # of A's, B's and C's
 - Currently 10% of our grades are D's and F's
- Action A

- Our MASA program (funded by PCEF) and some SCC funds help pay for teachers to assist students with homework help after school
- > This gives students more academic support

Action B

- ➤ Hired Reader/Graders give support to Social Studies and English classes
- > They provide more feedback for students and it helps the teachers turn over the assignments quicker

Action C

- Currently we have not been able to hire our Behavioral Support Supervisor
- ➤ This position is supposed to help students get back into the classroom by keeping them up to date with school work during in school suspension
- Part of the funds for this position have been diverted to the purchasing of Promethean Boards

Goal 3

> This helps fund students to take the AP tests
