Application for the Seal of Biliteracy

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award issued by the state department of education or local district to recognize a student who has attained proficiency in English and one or more other World Languages (Second Language) by high school graduation. The recognition of attaining biliteracy becomes part of the student's official Park City High School Transcript. The Seal serves to certify attainment of biliteracy for students, employers, and universities. It is a statement of accomplishment that helps to signal evidence of a student's readiness for career and college, and for engagement as a global citizen. Students are required to provide evidence of language proficiency in both English and a Second Language through any of the acceptable assessments listed below or on the chart on the back of this form. (http://sealofbiliteracy.org/state-guidelines)

Applications are due to the Park City High School Counseling Center by <u>May 15 of the student's SENIOR year</u>. Students should not submit this application <u>until they have taken the requisite assessments and can self-report their scores</u>*.

*AP Exception for Seniors: AP scores are released over the summer, therefore, Seniors waiting for their AP scores should submit their application by the May 15 deadline. Transcripts will be updated appropriately upon score verification in August.
