



Intent to Qualify for the Board of Education Academic Seal
Policy 9080 Graduation Requirements - Park City High School

Students will be eligible for a Board of Education Silver Academic Seal or Gold Academic Seal of Distinction on their diploma. Students must present the following qualifications to be eligible.

Requirements for the Board of Education Silver Academic Seal include:

- Successful completion of a minimum of 28 credits in grades 9-12, including the following requirements:
4 units of Language Arts
4 units of Social Studies (including the study of World Geography, World Civilization, United States Studies, and United States Government)
4 units of Mathematics
4 units of Science (including at least two of the following: Biology, Chemistry, Applied Physics, Physics, and Environmental Science)
3 units of one foreign language (or two years each of two different foreign languages)
2 units of Healthy Lifestyles1 (1.5) and Health (.5)
2 units of Career and Technical Education
.5 unit of Computer Technology
2 units of Fine Arts
2 units of Electives
.5 unit of General Financial Literacy
Minimum weighted GPA of 3.0
Successful completion of a minimum of 25 hours per year2 of community service. Qualifying activities include leadership roles in school or community, participation in service projects, and volunteer assistance for community activities. See the Verification of Community Service form on page 2.

Requirements for the Board of Education Gold Academic Seal of Distinction include:

- All requirements for the Silver Academic Seal listed above
Weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher
Successful completion of at least three Advanced Placement or equivalent college credit courses

1 Eleventh and twelfth grade students may fulfill a required .5 credit by participation in Park City High School varsity athletic teams for two sport seasons.
2 This requirement applies only to years that a student attends grades nine through twelve in Park City.
