


Challenges faced in Park City

- Average Median Income for a family of four is \$120,800
- Average annual salary for workforce is around \$43,000
- 70% of homes are second homes or short-term rentals.
- 85% of the workforce live outside Park City
- Limited land to develop Land cost is high
- Construction costs are high 30% to 60% higher than SLC
- Land Management Code does not incentives development of affordable housing
- · NIMBYism in the Community

PCSD Housing Challenges

- Employee recruitment/ retention
- ~40% of PCSD employees live outside Summit County
- ~25% of PCSD employees live in Park City
- ~75% of employees want to live within PCSD boundaries
- Almost 60% of PCSD employees spend more than 30% of their monthly income on housing.
- More than 60% of PCSD employees commute more than 15 minutes to
 Work.
